

## **Opening Position for A Tenure-Track Faculty in Orchestral Conducting**

### **General Information:**

The Music Department at National Sun Yat-sen University invites applications with minimum of two years of college teaching experience for a full-time, tenure-track faculty position in Orchestral Conducting.

### **Qualifications** (at least one of the following):

- 1) Doctorate degree
- 2) Assistant professor or higher ranking
- 3) International Music Competition Awards

### **Professional Experience** (at least one of the following):

- 1) DMA/PhD dissertation or the dissertation after received present ranking
- 2) Provide portfolio of at least five public orchestral performances, including copies of programs, video files of live conducting, and a scholarly writing about the performance interpretation based on the repertoire from one of the above concerts.

### **Teaching Duties:**

- 1) Orchestral Ensemble
- 2) Orchestra literature
- 3) Orchestral conducting pedagogy
- 4) Basic conducting
- 5) Orchestral repertoire

The position also requires supervision of graduate thesis, as well as service on department, college, and university committees as assigned. Proficiency in Chinese is required.

### **Required Information:**

- 1) Curriculum vita

- 2) An official copy of highest degree certificate
- 3) An official transcript for the highest degree
- 4) An official copy of teaching certificate issued by the Ministry of Education (R.O.C.) (optional)
- 5) At least one writing sample, which could be a dissertation, an article, or some other form of scholarly writing about music, also shared with a hard copy.
- 6) A list of performances/scholarly work with corresponding recordings, video, or other materials.
- 7) Three confidential letters of recommendation
- 8) Applicants are required to submit Form 2 and Form 3 with applicant's signature (website: <http://music.nsysu.edu.tw> )
